- Establish and maintain safe workplaces
- Develop and foster a safety culture throughout the Company
- Establish roles and responsibilities for workers and subcontractors
- Assess project and high risk activity risks and mitigate hazards on a regular ongoing basis, in consultation with workers, subcontractors and stakeholders
- Provide sufficient training, instruction, competency and supervision for tasks.
- Set measurable QSE objectives and targets across all business units, aimed at the elimination of work related injury and illness
- Communicate this and other WHS policies and procedures to workers and necessary parties
- Provide plant that is fit for purpose, properly maintained and operated in the manner it is intended.
- Provide dedicated QSE support staff and an appropriate level of resources.

Freyssinet Management is committed to continuous improvement through transparency of operation, consultation with the workforce and the non-negotiable mitigation of unsafe situations within the workplace.
